Why is she at an increased risk of developing postpartum 1.5 (20 Marks) haemorrhage? A 32 year old primi gravida was found to have a blood pressure of 02 140/100mm Hg, during her antenatal visit at 36 weeks of gestation. (20 Marks) List the risk to this mother during the antenatal period Give the investigations with reasons that you would do in this (20 Marks) patient.
